International Peace Light 2021

Join Palomar **Zone** as we gather for the 4th Annual Peace Light Sharing event, integrating with scouts from around the World for a phenomenal International Scouting Experience. This is your opportunity to take the Peace Light home with you to share **with others in your community. Bring a “miner’s” style oil lamp or an enclosed candle. Scouts/Leaders should wear Class “A” Uniform.**

For over a thousand years lamps have burned continuously in the Grotto of the Nativity in Bethlehem Israel where Jesus was born. Each year a child from Upper Austria is chosen to light **two blast proof miner’s lamps from a** continuously burning grotto lamp. The blast proof miners lamps are then transported on an Austrian Airlines jet from Tel Aviv Israel to Vienna Austria from where the Peace Light is distributed at a Service of Dedication to Scout delegations from across Europe. Each Scout is tasked with Sharing the Peace Light in their home countries.

Since 2004, Austrian Airlines has flown the miner’s lamps containing the Peace Light from Vienna to New York City. Scout Leaders light their lanterns from the miner’s lamps in New York and spread out across the United States and Mexico to share the Peace Light. The Peace Light was first brought to the United States by Canadian Scouts in 2001 to promote Peace after the events of September 11, 2001.
