This one-night educational camping adventure is designed for school and scout groups (grades 3-12).
Sleepover activities are aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards.

Each sleepover program includes:

- Orientation and activities with Dr. Zoolittle, the Zoo's own zany wildlife researcher
- Set up your own Zoo tent and camp at the Zoo's own Camp Timbuktu
- Live animal presentations
- Private bus tour
- S'mores around the campfire
- Guided nighttime stroll featuring nocturnal animals
- Breakfast
- Exclusive (pre-opening) morning animal viewing



Price: **\$90/guest** (students and adults) - includes breakfast with cereal, fruit and hot & cold beverages
Each participant must provide their own sack dinner. Wrappers and other garbage from the sack dinners will be used for a special conservation education activity after dinner.
