



To Our Scouting Family and Friends,

San Diego County has expanded vaccination availability to workers in childcare and education industries. This expansion includes volunteers who work with children in formal and informal public and private recreation programs. SDIC is required to certify that the youth recreation staff member works directly with youths. Certification must come on SDIC letterhead. Leaders working directly with youth must be active in-person activity cohort leaders or volunteers at a Council camp and actively supervising in-person activities. To support eligible adult cohort leaders wishing to get a vaccination, cohort leaders can request a verification letter by [clicking here](#) and completing the form. Cohort leaders should present a verification letter along with their Scouting membership card and state ID at the vaccination site.

To get a Scouting ID card, logon to www.my.scouting.org and under “My Profile”, download and print a copy of your membership card. Language on the card reads, “This certifies that [NAME], [VOLUNTEER TITLE] is an adult leader in the BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA [Council Name & Number] and is entitled to all the rights and privileges thereof to the last day of 12/31/2021. [Membership Number]”
