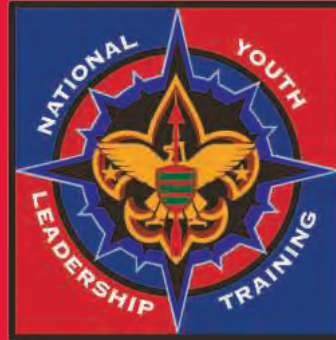

**TOTAL ESTIMATED COST: \$100,000**



Originally built in 1965, the Mataguay Conference Center is an integral part of the San Diego-Imperial Council's training programs. In recent years, the dining hall and casitas (dormitories) have been used primarily by Wood Badge, NYLT and COPE. These buildings are in desperate need of repair with roof leaks in the dining hall and casita #4. Additionally, there is major kitchen equipment and bathroom fixtures that need to be replaced.

These repairs have been deferred due to pressing needs in other parts of the camp. This is a grassroots campaign for Scouters to step up and raise the necessary funds to make the critical repairs to preserve these buildings.
