

Family Dens

For Cub Scout Leaders

The San Diego - Imperial Council has been chosen as a test Council for a new Family Dens Program! This will allow the formation of boys and girls co-ed dens in your pack. All Cub Scout Packs are invited to participate and the process to sign-up is easy.

1. Both the pack and the charter organization agree on the decision to allow co-ed dens in their pack.
2. The pack and the charter organization sign an Memorandum of Understanding ([MOU](#)) and turn that in to [Traci Urabe](#), SDIC Registrar.
3. The pack designates one person as Family Den Representative and provides that name and email to.
4. The representative must watch a webinar. A video link will be shared with all who complete the MOU

There are a few other important details. Each Den leader of a Family Den MUST be registered, the pack MUST use Scoutbook to set up all of their dens, and 5th grade AOL dens will remain single-gender to prepare for entry into Scouts BSA. Only packs that have signed the [MOU](#) and attend the webinar may utilize co-ed family dens. We strongly recommend that all family packs consider trying family dens.
