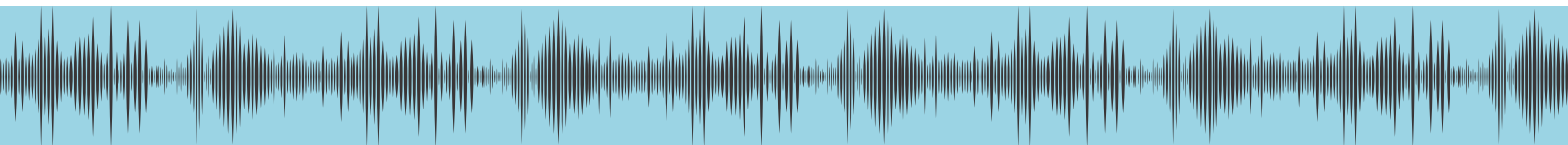
The Wood Badge curriculum covers a wide range of topics, including:
